These Regulations are the Food (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into operation on 1 February 2019.

(B) TO EXTEND THE USE OF CURRENTLY APPROVED FOOD ADDITIVES IN ADDITIONAL FOOD CATEGORIES

3. Butylated hydroxyanisole

Butylated hydroxyanisole (INS 320) and butylated hydroxytoluene (INS 321), will be allowed in a new food category "Breakfast cereals", at levels up to 200 ppm and 100 ppm respectively, calculated on the fat or oil basis. Internationally, the use of butylated hydroxyanisole and butylated hydroxytoluene in breakfast cereals has been endorsed by the Codex Alimentarius Commission, and is also permitted in Canada and the United States.
