

CONSULTATION ON DRAFT FOOD (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

These Regulations are the Food (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into operation on 1 February 2019.

(B) TO EXTEND THE USE OF CURRENTLY APPROVED FOOD ADDITIVES IN ADDITIONAL FOOD CATEGORIES

2. Dimethyl polysiloxane

Dimethyl polysiloxane (INS 900a), a permitted anti-foaming agent, will be allowed for use in four new food categories “Lactobacillus milk drinks or cultured milk drinks”, “Flavoured milk”, “Ready-to-drink coffee” and “Ready-to-drink tea”, at levels up to 10 ppm. Internationally, the use of dimethyl polysiloxane in one or more of these categories has been endorsed by the Codex Alimentarius Commission, and permitted in Australia, New Zealand, Canada, the European Union and the United States.
