

CONSULTATION ON DRAFT FOOD (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

These Regulations are the Food (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into operation on 1 February 2019.

(C) MAXIMUM LIMITS FOR INCIDENTAL CONSTITUENTS IN FOOD

1. Copper

Copper is regarded as a food quality contaminant in edible fats and oils by the Codex Alimentarius Commission, which has adopted maximum limits for copper for this food category.

In summary, the limits for copper in edible fats and oils are:

- 0.1 ppm, for refined fats and oils
- 0.4 ppm, for virgin fats and oils; and cold pressed fats and oils
- 0.4 ppm, for lard, rendered pork fat, premier jus (oleo stock) and dripping (edible tallow)
